Special Guest Shri P. A. Patel, Lead District Manager, Deena Bank, Patan. The program started with prayer to Almighty followed by University song which was sung in honour of university. A worldly welcome of guests and aims and objectives of workshop was done by Prof.(Dr.) Sangita Sharma, Chairperson of University Industry Linkage Cell. After floral welcome by buckays and mementos, the activities of this cell were highlighted by Dr. Jay Trivedi.

During inaugural function,

- Shri D. V. Patel, an industrialist of Mehsana highlighted the role of universities in building the industries. He explained how the gap between the industries and universities can be reduced and it will certainly improve job opportunities in the area. He also advised the students to take the risk and take advantage of available all opportunities and technologies. He shared his personal experiences how he started his carrier from the grass root level and reached to present level. Dr. D. J. Patel, also elaborated role university in nation building and why Industry should coordinate with in various branches of Sciences (like life Sciences, Food and technology, Biotechnology etc.), commerce, Technology and Law etc.

 - Dr. Dipooaba Devada madam explained about the activities of the university and highlighted how university can be boon for growth of regional industries. She assured that university will take all possible initiatives so that inputs from industry are incorporated in syllabus of different subject streams, so that students of our industry can directly join some of the regional industries after completion of their courses.

- In afternoon sessions
- Shri D.J. Patel, Manager Zilla Udhyog Kendra, Patan has explained the all schemes of Gujarat state for development of small scale industries like raring of animals cows, buffalows, poultry form etc. How students can make use of these schemes and participate them. How much subsidy Govt can provide for these units. He highligted students can earn along with their studies and contribute to society also. He distributed pamphlets of these schemes to all participants.

 - Shri P. A. Patel, Lead District Manager, Deena Bank, Patan highlighted role of banks for in financing Govt schemes as well as private small scale industries. He explained the loans that students can obtain from for studies in India and abroad. He gave details about interest free and with interest loans for small scale units.

- After these long explanatory lectures, there was questions & answers session with the experts. In that session, there was direct discussed between participants and Experts. In the session many queries were raised by participants. Some of them are regarding schemes of banks and Govt accessible to students during their studies. What are risk factors for opting for these schemes.

- There were 267 participants in the workshops. Participants were Ph, D. and M. Phil. students, M. Sc. students from sciences (Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Microbiology, biotechnology), Graduate students from BBA and M.Sc. IT and other departments of our campus departments and some students from colleges affiliated to HNGU.
